75% of street boys in Kathmandu are victims of sexual abuse at the hands of foreigners, locals and their peers.

How children end up homeless on the streets of Kathmandu

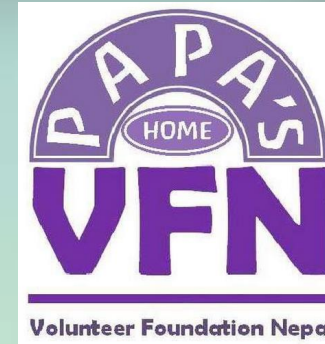
41% of children leave home due to family violence

27% due to peer influence

19% due to economic factors

15% due to disintegration of the family

70% of those street children sniffing shoe- glue so they dont have to face the reality. Young boys clutching bags of solvents on harsh streets. When surely they should have been holding soft toys in loving homes





## VOLUNTEER FOUNDATION NEPAL. "PAPA'S HOME"

VFN Founded in 2010 by Lalit Shahi.

The combined effort of Nepali citizen *Lalit Shahi* and retired UK school teacher *Eric Fairman*, created: 'Papa's Home. Papa's Home is located in Kupondol, a suburb of Kathmandu.

It is estimated that there are +/- 4.000 children surviving on the streets of Nepal. Living their lives collecting plastic bottles for re-sale, begging from passers-by and checking garbage bins for something to eat.

VFN is a project aimed at offering shelter to children of the streets and other vulnerable children







After offering help and food, Eric and Lalit got to know the children in one particular group from the district of Kathmandu. Admittedly they were dirty with lice infested diseased skin, and addicted to glue-sniffing.... But they are children. Children who needed to be noticed, to be recognized as being important! Children who needed some love and care in their daily lives.

It was decided that those kids needed a home! VFN would give them one!

A rough estimate based on costs for VFN's shelter home accommodating 20 vulnerable children, indicated The kids needed a 'papa' as much as they needed accommodation! The shelter became an orphanage. After they got the money together they just needed a name for the project: Papa's Home.

The project 'Papa's Home' was launched on the 1st September, 2012

The home is a small project, currently caring for 33 children. 28 boys and 5 girls. Most of them are younger than the age of 12.

After lots of effort Papa's home has become a focus for helping a few of the many hundreds of street children in Kathmandu.



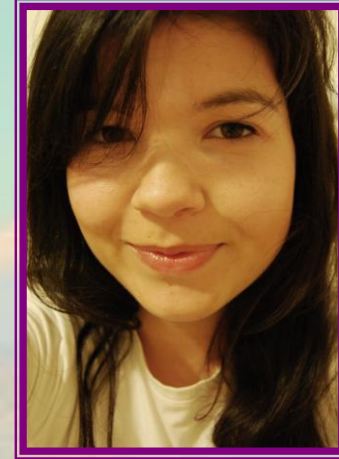


## Who we are:
