

OUR BRIEF STORY


Ponds with Life Project was born in 2011 with the main goal to promote the participation of all citizens in the discovery, valorization and conservation of ponds and their biodiversity and develop the 1st National Pond Survey.

After the first years, we had excellent results and great public projection!



However, the Project is now on its final financing phase, which means we have to make all efforts to keep it running next year!

WHAT WE NEED



*development, design and printing of Guides and ID Keys of amphibian larvae, macro-invertebrate, pond plants, etc.

To guarantee its continuation “Don’t Let Ponds Without Life” intends to:

1. Guarantee the work developed for citizen awareness and pond’s biodiversity conservation;
2. Finish new support material for pond study such as ID Keys and Guides - Amphibian larvae/Macroinvertebrate/Freshwater plants;
3. Continue ongoing scientific studies on waterbodies’ biodiversity.

WHAT WILL BE THE IMPACT OF YOUR HELP

You will be directly involved with Pond Conservation! With your help we predict the following results for next year:

- + 174 ponds surveyed (reaching more than 2000 ponds!);
- + 20 created ponds;
- + 42 activities developed and involving 1060 more students;
- + 26 courses, allowing 390 trainees to obtain knowledge on pond conservancy;
- + 3 brand new ID Keys (Amphibian Larvae, Macroinvertebrates, Freshwater Plants);
- + 1 bachelor thesis;
- + 1 master thesis.



WHAT WILL BE THE IMPACT ON YOU!

Have you ever stopped to think about why ponds are important?? Besides having greater biodiversity than rivers and lakes, ponds can give us several benefits:

1. Decrease the effect of climate changes: flood control (acting as sponges), capture atmospheric carbon (due to presence of several plant species), etc.;
2. Reserve freshwater and slowly purify it before it reaches our home (can be used as phytoremediation stations - use of plants to purify water);
3. Guarantee nutrient regulation and high primary productivity (provided by plants), much need to all food chain, where we are inserted;
4. Help control plagues: amphibians/dragonfly larvae eat a lot of biting mosquitos and farm plagues!;
5. Have high scientific, pedagogic and aesthetic value (ponds are beautiful to look upon and contribute to good physical and mental health).

However, ponds are being threatened by:

1. Habitat destruction;
2. Pollution (agro-chemicals, discharge of domestic sewage/livestock, garbage deposition);
3. Climatic changes, leading to more frequent droughts;
4. Incorrect management practices (i.e.: pond/tank dry out in cities during species reproduction);
5. Emerging (new) diseases that kill entire populations (i.e: quitridiomicosis for amphibians);




4. Pond Explorer KIT
